Based on our review, we find that the submitted sample is not an NFA firearm, but falls entirely within the purview of the GCA. It is a "firearm" as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 921(a)(3); further, it is a "pistol" as defined. However, if used without the pistol grip attached, the submitted sample would be subject to the NFA and classified as an "AOW."

FTISB also noted that the markings on the submitted sample are not in compliance with 27 CFR § 478.92. It appears that the "Ideal Conceal" and "Monticello MN" are marked on the barrel. However, because of the paint on the barrel, these markings are not conspicuous. Also, the submitted sample is missing a caliber designation.

We caution that these findings are based on the received sample. If the design, dimensions, configuration, method of operation, or materials used were changed, this classification would be subject to review.
